Based on art of presentation /methodology/ work presented /interaction / time control

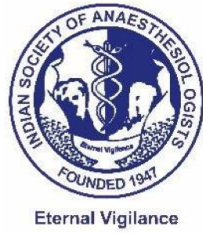

- 6 minutes presentation + 2 minutes discussion,

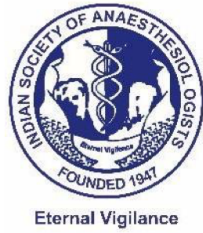
Selection and Award

ISA DR. B.B. MISHRA YOUNG ANAESTHESIOLOGIST NATIONAL AWARD

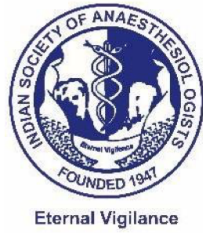
- This session consists of presentation by young Anaesthesiologists defined as Senior Resident or Assistant Professor or Practitioner (all with less than 10 years post first PG degree, including those who do DNB, post DA after time gap), who are Life Members of ISA
- They should not have presented lectures as faculty (speaker/ chairperson) / young speaker at National conferences of ISA earlier
- A self-declaration to this effect (above two) shall be submitted online
- The final on stage presentation for selected presenters shall be for 6 min (plus 2 min discussion) of a lecture topic allotted by the Scientific Committee
- Please provide documents to support your educational qualification and designation (Degree certificate and registration certificate, Present appointment letter)

- If selected, the presenter will NOT be eligible to participate in the same session in future ISACON (National)
- The ISA Academic Committee in coordination with the Scientific Committee of ISACON will choose the best among the applications through blinded online review system and inform the finalists through SMS and Email.
- Submissions are only through the designated link in ISACON website
- Submissions through e mail/ abstract portal will not be considered.
- The applicant shall submit the CV and related details mentioned above (including Degree Certificate & Medical Council Registration Certificate) online with necessary attachments as proof.
- Certificates of paper presentation, awards and first page of papers published are considered as proof for presentation and publication and can be uploaded in CV.
- Please do not upload certificates of attendance as delegates for ISA conferences/ workshops. They do not have any consideration.
- File size of CV should not exceed 50 kB.
- The Award consists of medal, certificate and cash award (First Prize-10000 INR, Second Prize-5000 INR, Third Prize- 3000 INR).
- The Applicant should be a member of ISA.

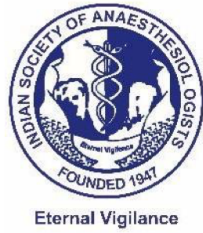
ISA DR. M. T. BHATIA YOUNG PAIN PHYSICIAN NATIONAL AWARD

- He or she should be within 10 years after post-graduation. MD/DNB Degree certificate should be included during submission of abstract
- The award is restricted to research on Chronic pain or cancer pain
- It will be a 6 minutes presentation + 2 minutes discussion
- Total duration of the session will be 90 minutes
- Prize-10000 INR, Second Prize-5000 INR, Third Prize- 3000 INR)

DR. ISA DR. ASHOK JADHAV MEMORIAL NATIONAL AWARD

The award is in the memory of Late Dr. Ashok Jadhav, a very successful, ethical, honest, and eminent private practitioner anaesthesiologist of Nagpur by his family and ISA Nagpur City Branch.

The award is for the best three papers in the private practitioner's forum of the Annual National Conference of the Indian Society of Anaesthesiologists (ISA).

Eligibility

1. Only life member of ISA are eligible for the Award.
2. The Award will be given only once in a life time to the member.
3. The evaluation will be objective in nature as far as possible.

Selection

- a. Priority will be given in the following order to - randomized trials, retrospective trials, case series, case reports in the above order.
- b. Originality of the report

c. Novelty of the report, for example, if there is any new message or a new technique or a difficult clinical problem solved using a novel technique that can influence the anaesthesiology practice.

d. Does it lead to any new research ideas?

e. Quality of presentation, including quality of slides, sticking to time limit, language, conclusions drawn.

f. Quality of answers given to the judges and audience questions.

4. The presentation should not violate ethical standards and practice guidelines to the extent possible.

5. The duration of presentation will be 6 minutes, followed by a 2 minute discussion.

6. The award would consist of:

First prize: Certificate, Medal and cash reward of INR 10,000 only

Second prize: Certificate, Medal and cash reward of INR 5,000 only

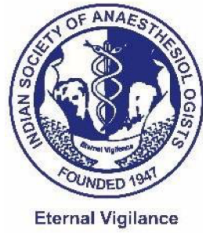
Third Prize: Certificate, Medal and cash reward of INR 3,000 only.

7. The Applicant should be a member of ISA.

ISA ALL BY MYSELF AWARD

- This session consists of presentation by any life member of ISA about his/her experience of difficulty/ complications /catastrophic / near catastrophic events, etc. in his/ her practice
- The presentation shall convey what and how the event was encountered, detected and managed, single handedly / ALL ALONE
- He/she may be assisted by OT technicians and ward boys while managing the case/situation (Postgraduate support is also considered as two anaesthesiologists, hence does not fit for this award). A self-declaration should be submitted.
- Case/management/encounter shall be preferably in a resource limited/ rural setting.
- There should not be gross deviation from accepted standard scientific practice related to the reported/ presented scenario/ case.
- Applicants should submit a short write up (maximum 250 words excluding title) of

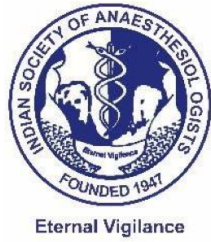
presenting topic through online portal, which will be screened by Academic Committee of ISA in coordination with Scientific Committee of ISACON for final selection.

- The final onstage presentation for selected presenters shall be for 5 min only with 1 min of discussion
- The Academic Committee of ISA in coordination with the Scientific Committee of ISA will choose the best among the applications through blinded online review system and inform the finalists through SMS and E mail.
- The decision of the Committee is final and will not be changed.
- The need for deviation in management of case / innovation should be highlighted clearly.
- Necessary videos and photos may be used for presentation, but prerecorded voice in videos is strictly prohibited
- The Award consists of medal, certificate and cash award (First Prize-10000 INR, Second Prize - 5000 INR, Third Prize - 3000 INR).
- The Applicant should be a member of ISA.

ISA INNOVATION NATIONAL AWARD

This session consists of presentation by Life Member / Associate Life member of ISA about his/her innovation related to help and improvement in practice of anaesthesia and patient management in terms of machines, devices, technology, automation, networking, Applications (web and mobile), etc for diagnosis, management, prophylaxis, data storage and analysis, Innovative Teaching modules / Apps for students, etc.

The submission shall convey

1. The physical, chemical, biological and technological basis of the innovation, its design / formula, discuss the usage in lab / manikins / animals / simulations / clinical cases / trials, etc.,
2. The safety and ethical considerations / whether Ethical Committee Approval is taken for safety profile and use in practice / in vivo
3. Issues related to copyright, patenting if any
4. Production / manufacture Considerations in India ('make in India')/abroad

5. Economic considerations

6. Can the ISA Innovation Committee and IJA help? Elucidate in your preparation

- Applicants should submit a short write up (of less than 250 words) of their innovation through online portal on the ISACON website for review and possible final selection.
- The Innovation Committee of ISA in coordination with the Scientific Committee of ISACON will choose the best among the applications through online review system and inform the finalists through SMS and Email.
- There will be 6 final presenters and the final on stage presentation for selected presenters shall be for 3 min only with 2 min discussion.
- The decision of the Committee is final and will not be changed.

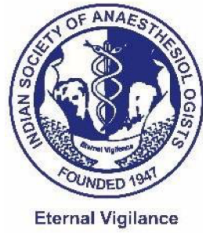
Submission Details

- Submissions are only through the designated link on ISACON website. Submissions through e-mail will not be considered. (unless specifically asked by the Committees)
- Applicants should submit a short write up (maximum 250 words excluding title) of presenting topic through online portal, which will be screened by Innovation Committee of ISA in coordination with Scientific Committee of ISACON for final selection.
- The final 6 participants will be chosen by the Innovation Committee and informed to the ISACON Scientific Committee
- The award winners and others are encouraged to interact with ISA Innovation Committee and the Committee will guide them on further technological update, copyright, patent, marketing in the field
- The Award consists of medal, certificate and cash award (First Prize-10000 INR, Second Prize-5000 INR, Third Prize- 3000 INR).

ONE MINUTE NATIONAL AWARD

This session Consists of One minute Power Point presentation on any topic by any Life member (not for Trainees / Associate Life Members) on any Anaesthesia / Critical Care / Pain / Palliative Care (practice, devices, new knowledge, innovations, software, anecdotal experience, medico-legal, etc.,).

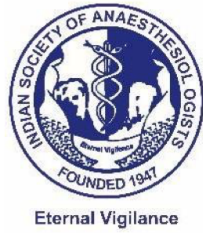
- The applicants will be chosen for final presentation based on short write up of topic to be presented.
- The ISA Academic Committee in coordination with the Scientific Committee of ISACON will choose the best among the submissions through blinded online review system and inform the finalists through SMS and E mail.
- The decision of the scientific committee is final and will not be changed.
- Applicants should submit short write up of topic to be presented (max.150 words only) through designated ISACON website link.
- Submissions are to be made only through the link in ISACON Website.
- Submissions through email/ abstract portal will not be considered.

- The on stage presentation shall consist of ONE Minute PPT with Maximum 3 slides and can include text, illustrations and videos (no prerecorded audio allowed). This will be followed by a 2 minute discussion.
- The first slide of the 3 slides should be title slide.
- The award consists of medal, certificate and cash award (First Prize-10000 INR, Second Prize- 5000 INR, Third Prize- 3000 INR).
- The Applicant should be a member of ISA.

ISA TRAINEE TALENT NATIONAL AWARD

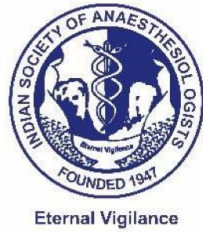
- This session consists of presentation by trainees / post graduates (DA, MD, DNB, DM) who are Life Associate Members of ISA
- The applicant shall be an active trainee / PG as on ISACON conference date. A certificate duly signed by the Head of the department to this effect shall be submitted online (check below / upload area)
- The applicants will be chosen for final presentation based on a one minute video, of presenter presenting a Power Point presentation on any anaesthesia topic of their choice (see below for details/ upload area)
- The final onstage presentation for selected presenters shall be for 5 minutes on a lecture topic allotted by the Scientific Committee of ISACON and can include videos/ illustrations and it will be followed by a 1 minute discussion. However, pre voice recorded videos are strictly prohibited and such presentations will not be eligible for prizes.
- The Academic Committee of ISA in coordination with the Scientific Committee of ISACON will choose the best 20 (twenty only) among the submissions for the session through blinded online review system and inform the finalists through SMS and Email.

- Applicants should submit a preliminary video of “one minute only” on anaesthesia / Critical Care / Pain / Palliative Care topic through a designated link in the ISACON website.
- Submissions through e-mail will not be considered (unless specifically asked by the Committee)
- The acceptable formats allowed for video upload are MPEG/MP/WMV and the videos should strictly be less than 100 MB size. (If video is more than a minute, application will be rejected straight away)
- Submit a short CV of size less than 50 kB in pdf format.
- This One-minute presentation shall not reveal the name and institute affiliation of the presenter or any other names / identities in the video. If found so, the application will be rejected straightaway.
- Submissions other than through the designated link in website (e mail/ abstract portal) will not be considered.
- The Award consists of medal, certificate and cash award (First Prize-10000 INR, Second Prize-5000 INR, Third Prize- 3000 INR).

ISH - NARANI BEST POSTER NATIONAL AWARD

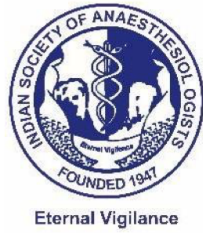
1. This award is intended to increase the academic and research activities of practicing anaesthesiologists and PG Students in clinical anaesthesiology, perioperative medicine, critical care & pain medicine.
2. Only members of ISA are eligible to participate in this competition.
3. Preference will be given to original research work.
4. Ten best e-posters will be selected from the e-posters submitted for e-poster presentation by the Chairman Scientific Committee. These 10 posters will be presented in a special session in the ISA National Conference every year.
5. This award will be presented for the best research paper presented in the poster format.
6. Three judges nominated by the Chairman Scientific Committee will evaluate these 10 posters on different criteria's like scientific content, presentation style etc. The presenter who gets the maximum marks will be awarded.

7. The award consists of certificate and cash prize. First prize of Rs. 10000/- goes to best poster presenter. The remaining awards for 2nd/3rd place to successful participants carry certificates and cash award of Rs. 5000/- and Rs. 3000/- sponsored by ISA. All 10 finalists will get Certificates.
8. The award will be announced immediately after the poster presentation.
9. Timing of poster presentation will be decided by the organizers.
10. The decision of the Chairman Scientific Committee/Judges for selecting the papers for the award and the decision of the judges will be final and binding to all.
11. It is mandatory that the first (main) author should also be the presenting author and the award will only be given to the first author.
12. Submission through e-poster portal (non-award category)

ISA LUDHIANA BEST POSTER NATIONAL AWARD & TRAVEL GRANTS

This 'competition and traveling grants' is only for anaesthesia postgraduate students whose poster is adjudged as the Best Poster in their state level PG poster competition.

Rules & Regulations:

1. Only ISA members who are doing post-graduation in anaesthesia are permitted to participate.
2. Last date of receiving the nomination is 10th November of every year.
3. 12-15 Travel grants, one per state to a member of ISA (if more states apply, selection will be done by Scientific Committee on Rotation). The travel grant will be given every year to attend the Annual National Conference of ISA. The amount of grant will be Rs. 2,500/- to each participant to meet the travel expenses. (Actual number of grants varies every year)

Selection

The Selection of the participating candidate will be done by the ISA State Chapter based on the guidelines that:

- a. He / She must be a PG student at the time when he / she presented the poster in respective State Annual Conference of the year.
- b. His / Her poster was adjudged as the Best Poster amongst the postgraduates who presented the posters in State Annual Conference.
- c. He / She will present the same poster as Poster in the Annual National Conference of ISA immediately following the State Conference.
- d. State units may support the participant financially to attend the national conference
- e. It must be a scientific study only.

Submission

He / She should submit a certificate endorsing the above facts, from respective ISA State Branch Secretary to The Hon. Secretary ISA National Head Quarters (ISA NHQ) for inclusion of name in the competition. At places where no state chapters are functioning, the poster with the recommendation from ISA City Branch Secretary will be accepted with the provision that only one poster allowed from a state.

Also, the abstract submitted to ISA secretary national should be uploaded in the designated link in the ISACON website before the last date.

Competition for medal

- All such posters accepted for competition will be presented as poster in one session on the day one of the conference every year.
- This is an ISA function.

- The President ISA will chair the session. The Hon. Secretary ISA will anchor the session. The Vice President ISA will be the coordinator of the function. The Chairperson will introduce the theme of this award and the contributors to the audience.
- The judging team will consist of (a) Vice President ISA (b) Editor IJA (c) One Past President ISA.
- Time allotted for presentation will be 3 minutes followed by 1 minutes of discussion
- Only judges are allowed to ask questions.
- After valuation of the poster presented, with the permission of the judges, audience can interact with the presenter, if time available. Judging of poster will be based on the art of presentation, methodology of the work presented, the poster quality and answering of the questions.

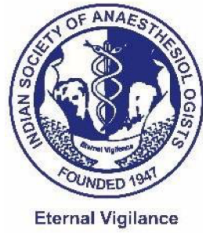
Results and Awards

- The President ISA will declare the Best Poster presented at the end of the session and two winners (1st and 2nd) will be given Medal, Certificates and cash award (First Prize-10000 INR, Second Prize-5000 INR) at AGM / Valedictory functions of ISA.
- Travel grants and certificates will be distributed from Office of Secretary on participation at the competition.

DR. T.N. JHA AND DR. K.P. CHANSORIYA MEMORIAL NATIONAL MEDAL AND TRAVELLING GRANTS

This 'Medal and Traveling Grants' competition, reserved for anaesthesia postgraduate students was originally donated by family of late Dr. T.N. Jha and his colleagues. Owing to financial paucity to run the programme, a generous contribution was received from Dr. K.P. Chansoriya (Past National President of ISA) and the name is now changed to Dr. T.N. Jha and Dr. K.P. Chansoriya Memorial National Medal and Travelling Grant.

Rules & Regulations:

1. Only ISA member - anaesthesia postgraduate students are permitted to participate.
2. Last date of receiving the nomination is 10th November of every year.

Twelve Travel grants, one each to a member of ISA, from twelve states (if more states apply, selection will be done by Scientific Committee / on Rotation); will be given every year to attend the Annual National Conference of ISA. The amount of grant will be Rs.1000/- to each participant to meet the travel expenses. (Actual number of grants varies every year)

Selection

The Selection of the participating - candidate will be done by the State chapter based on the guidelines that:

1. He / She must be a PG student at the time when he / she read the paper in respective State Annual Conference of the year.
2. His / Her paper will be adjudged as the best from PG s who read the paper in State Annual Conference.
3. He / She will present the same paper in the Annual National Conference of ISA, immediately following the State Conference.
4. State units may support the participant financially to attend the national conference.

Submission

He / She should submit a certificate endorsing the above facts, from Hon. Secretary of ISA of respective state to ISA Secretary at HQ for inclusion of name in the competition. At places, where no state chapters are functioning, the paper with the recommendation from ISA City Branch Secretary will be accepted with the provision that only one paper allowed from a state.

Also, the abstract submitted to ISA secretary national should be uploaded in the designated link in the ISACON website before the last date.

Competition for medal

All such papers accepted for competition, will be read in one session on the day one of the conference every year. This is an ISA function. The President ISA will chair the session. The Hon. Secretary ISA will anchor the session. The Vice President, ISA will be the coordinator of the function. The Chairperson will introduce the theme of this award and the donors to the audience.

The judging team will consist of (a) Vice President ISA (b) Editor IJA (c) One Past President ISA. Time allotted for presentation will be 8 minutes followed by 2 minutes of interaction. Only judges are allowed to ask questions. After valuation of the paper presented, with the permission of the chair, audience can interact with the presenter, if time available. Judging of paper will be based on the art of presentation of the paper, methodology of the work presented and the audience control while presenting and answering of the questions.

Result and Award

The President ISA will declare the best paper presented at the end of the session and the winner is entitled for Dr. T.N. Jha and Dr. K.P. Chansoriya Memorial National Medal. Certificate and cash award of 10,000 INR which will be awarded at AGM / Valedictory functions of ISA. Travel grants and certificates will be distributed from office of Secretary on participation at the competition.
